Sub: Consideration of promotion by taking into account the property returns submitted w.r.t. the G.A. & P.G. (SE) Department Circular No. 659/SE dated 24.05.2023

Sir,

I am directed to invite reference to the subject cited above and to say that the provisions inserted in the Odisha Government Servants' Conduct Rules, 1959 vide the Odisha Government Servants' Conduct (Amendment) Rules, 2021 prescribes that "*Every Government servant, from the level of Group-A to Group-D is required to make a true and complete declaration of all his assets, movable and immovable, and the value thereof as on the 1<sup>st</sup> January every year ONLINE in HRMS Portal on or before the 31<sup>st</sup> January of that year"..... "Besides, up to date filing of property return will be a prerequisite for promotion".* 

In the meantime, with a view to ensure submission of annual property statement by the defaulting employees, the last date for submission of property statement for the year 2022 online in HRMS has been extended by the Government upto 30.06.2023. Besides, a considered view has also been taken by the Government as a onetime measure in respect of the employees who have defaulted in submission of property statement from the year 2016 onwards to avail benefits by submitting the same online in HRMS during the period 01.06.2023 to 30.06.2023.

It is therefore, instructed that the property statement submitted by the defaulting Government Servants with reference to the G.A. & P.G. (SE) Department

Circular No. 659/SE dated 24.05.2023 shall be taken into consideration at the time of consideration of promotion of the respective employees by convening review DPC/regular DPC wherever applicable and their seniority in the respective ranks may be restored accordingly.

The above instructions may be followed scrupulously in every case.
